Creativity Camp Principles:

Creativity comes from ideas.

Ideas come from *looking* and *remembering* and *imagining*.

Ideas can be expressed in many ways.

Each and every person is creative idea maker.

In appropriate age groups, kids will work in four artistic disciplines each day:

Literary Arts: book making, storytelling, poetry, journaling

Drama: play acting, imaginative prop play, drama exercises and vocal technique

Creative Movement: kinesthetic idea expression, body awareness and control

Visual Arts: drawing and painting, sculpture, puppetry

Each camp uses an environmental theme and process-based learning to inspire art-making.

We'll start by using our ordinary eyes, ears, noses, feet, legs, arms, hands and faces to take in our natural world. We'll use our collection of observations to form reactions and express them through art. Teaching artists emphasize solid instruction in proper technique and a child's personal satisfaction with his/her work. Environmental educators add science and experiences.

Children's literature becomes another layer.
