

# Festival Theatre Announces Virtual Youth Auditions for *Stuart Little* \*UPDATED\* Audition Videos DUE JUNE 10TH

**ABOUT THE SHOW:** The endearing classic about a mouse named Stuart Little who is born into an ordinary New York family comes to life on the stage! All the charm, wisdom and joy of the E.B. White original are captured in this adaptation by Joseph Robinette. The many adventures—both big and small—of Stuart Little are brought vividly to life in this story theatre presentation.

**WHO:** We are looking for 15-20 youth actors between the ages of 8-18 to join a cast of adult actors as part of our 2020 Theatre Series. All youth roles will be double cast.

**REHEARSALS:** Rehearsals for *Stuart Little* will begin **September 1st**. We generally rehearse 4-5 days a week between 4:00pm and 8:30pm throughout the week and noon and 6:00pm on the weekends. To aid us in creating a successful rehearsal calendar, please be as accurate and detailed as possible with known and potential conflicts on audition registration form. A complete rehearsal schedule will be made available to cast members at the first rehearsal.

**What is needed for the AUDITION?**

- A COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORM with all scheduling conflicts during the listed rehearsal and performance schedules. Registration forms can be found at <http://www.festivaltheatre.org/youth-and-family-series.html> or picked up at Festival Theatre.
- A RECENT PHOTO (headshot preferred – school photo is fine)
- A video audition, totaling no more than 3 minutes in length. This video should include:
  - An introduction including your name, age, and title of your piece
  - A little bit about yourself. This can be some things you like to do, something about your family, or even a funny story. Show us a little bit of your personality!
  - A memorized monologue (30-45 seconds only-- not longer). Choose a piece from a play, a poem, a very short story, part of a story, or even a joke!
